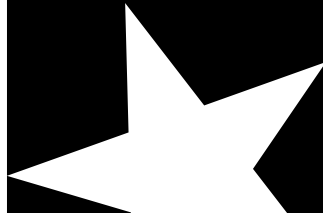

# A Growing Transportation Program

Earlier this year, Easterseals NH acquired a property at 782 Gold Street in South Manchester, the new home of our **Transportation Services** program. The space allows us to further establish our status as a provider of choice for demand response and special education student transportation in the community.

Reliable transportation is imperative to the more than 900 children and adults of all abilities our drivers and monitors serve each year. Take Paul, for example—he has been utilizing our Transportation Services for more than 10 years.

After a serious car accident, Paul, a senior, initially relied on family members to help him fulfill his essential errands. Paul's brother mentioned to him that he should reach out to Easterseals NH to see which options were available to him.

Today, he uses our shuttles to do everything from obtaining prescriptions and attending medical appointments to shopping and conducting banking transactions.

Paul values his independence, mobility, and the ability to stay in his home thanks to utilizing our services. He has even referred other folks to the program. "I couldn't be more satisfied with the program," he says. "Easterseals NH is everything to me."
