We are transforming our 15-acre campus and facilities in Franklin into a unique center of excellence for the military community. Designed and developed by PROCON, the campus will provide housing, a retreat center, and enhanced support for service members, veterans and their families through centralized access to a variety of services and recreation activities.



Phased Development

Easterseals NH was awarded funding to develop the initial phase campus and its programs, but **it will take all of us working together** to realize this important vision to the fullest and sustain the campus for future generations.

Phase I construction, including housing and the retreat center, is expected to be completed by **Summer 2025**.

Phase II will unfold dependent on additional funding raised of \$23M.

Funding

Easterseals NH was awarded \$23M from the State of New Hampshire through the **American Rescue Plan Act State Fiscal Recovery Funds** to develop the first phase of this unique campus for military members and their families. **Additional funds will be needed to complete Phase II**, including the multi-purpose recreation center, maker's space and possible VA Clinic.
